Topic 01 Nature Information

On Tuesday, October 28th, heavy snow and strong winds caused numerous trees to fall in the areas around Asahidake Onsen and Tenninkyo Onsen. From late the following night, the 29th, until past 3:00 PM, a power outage occurred, cutting off electricity, water, and radio waves. Without heating equipment, toilets, running water, or phones, the area became cut off from the outside world. This incident served as a stark reminder that even in mountainous environments, daily preparedness is crucial.

Preparing disaster or heavy snowfall supplies in advance is effective for being ready during emergencies. e.g. Cell phone batteries, emergency power sources, emergency food, cold-weather clothing, emergency water bottles, buckets, disposable toilet bag, lanterns, kerosene stoves, shovels, rope (for clearing fallen trees), headlamps, blankets, gas canisters, etc.

The Hokkaido subspecies of the Japanese jay, the *Miyama kakesu*, has arrived in the vicinity of Asahidake Onsen. It inhabits forests throughout Hokkaido, uttering a *je-je* call and mimicking the songs of other birds. They also have the nature of storing nuts and other food in the ground or on tree trunks. In the *Ainu* language, it is called *Eyami*, meaning the *talkative bird god*.
