Snowshoes are tools for walking on the snow. Snowshoes originated in Central Asia more than 6,000 years ago, almost the same as skiing. The early shapes of snowshoes resemble 'Kanjiki' as we know, attached to a mesh of leather and strings on a wooden frame for hunting and living on the harsh winter land. With the wisdom of our predecessors, we can now walk on snow more comfortably and safely. Snowshoes are an essential tool for our safety when we walk on winter mountains where heavy snow is falling or snow trekking.





Introduction of two types of snowshoes we can rent



[ATLAS]

Attas snowshoes company was started from San Francisco in 1990. The Attas has been developed for use in mountainous areas, as apposed to traditional snowshoes that were supposed to walk on flat ground. Its light weight type is made by soft nylon that is easy for women to use.



(TUBBS)

Tubbs was started in 1906 by Watter Frederick Tubbs in Norway, Maine. It is a long-established manufacturer representing snowshoes with a history of more than 100 years. It is easy to take off and put on, and the heel is raised for up hill.
