Yezo sika deer (Cervus nippon yesoensis) lives only in Hokkaido]

Classification: A species of deer in the family Cervidae, genus Cervus. It is one size larger in length than Cervus nippon. Length: up to 190 cm, Weight: 100 kg for females, up to 200 kg for males. Lifespan: 14–20 years. Characteristics: They have a voracious appetite both day and night. In spring and summer, they are herbivores, and in fall and winter, they feed mainly on grass, bark, young shoots, and fallen leaves. Only males have sharp horns, which are removed in spring and replaced by new horns.In summer, a white spotted pattern called "fawn pattern" is visible, but it disappears in winter. Deer are timid, so please be careful not to approach them.

More than 2,000 traffic accidents involving Yezo sika deer occur every year in Hokkaido, with the number exceeding 4,000 in 2022, the highest number ever recorded. More than 70% of traffic accidents occur between 16:00 and 24:00. Deer tend to form groups and suddenly cross the road or jump out of the way. Motorists are advised to turn on their lights early in the morning and night, drive carefully to avoid approaching deer by keeping their lights on and their speed low.
